

Genealogical Data Extracted from Barnaul Region Settlement Documents (1907-1915)

State Archive of Tomsk Oblast

Over the last few years Russian language files regarding the movement and settling of Mennonites in the [Barnaul](#) colony (also known as the Slavgorod Mennonite Settlement) have appeared on the website "[Mennonitische Geschichte und Ahnenforschung](#)". This collection is a treasure trove of genealogical information on this group of settlers. Below are translated extracts of these documents. Details on the source for each archival document are provided at the beginning of the translation, as are links to the scans of the original document. I have translated some of the Russian village names to their more familiar German form as well as made a few comments. These are in square brackets.
