These families arrived sometime on, or before, 1848. This is an accounting as of 1848. The last column is the number of the household head in the GRANDMA database. The list appears to include Leonhard Suderman, elder of the Berdyansk Mennonite Church and one of the twelve delegates who traveled to America in 1873. The *Mennonite Encyclopedia* states that he immigrated to Russia in 1841 and settled in Berdyansk in 1843.

This list replaces an earlier version translated by Nikolai Mazharenko in June 2001.
