

List of the Original Settlers in Tiegerweide, Molotschna Mennonite Settlement, 1822

The following list originates with a handwritten copy found in the files of Mennonite Genealogy Inc. The original simply contains the names of the heads of the 24 original settlers in Tiegerweide, Molotschna Mennonite Settlement, South Russia, placed into two groups: those who immigrated directly from Prussia and those who were children of earlier immigrants. The list below follows the original order. I have added information available for them from the 1835 census. It should be noted that many of the families who immigrated to Russia from Prussia stayed in temporary accommodations, often with family or friends who had immigrated earlier. This can be seen from the information in columns 3 and 4. There are 5 families for which I lack definitive information. These are highlighted in gray. The 4th column provided the likely number of the household head in the GRANDMA database. Much more information on these families can be found in GRANDMA.

Note that the 1835 Molotschna census shows that the following Wirtschaften were taken over after 1822 by men not listed above: #1 (1833), #2 (1828), #5 (1833), #6 (1833), #10 (1827), #13 (1833), #21 (1823), #22 (1823).
