

Forstei List H: Gerhard Froese Lists: 1885-1889

The diary of Gerhard P. Froese contains a list of those who served with him in the Forstei. The dairy, which includes his experiences in the Forstei, has been translated by William Schroeder of Winnipeg and is available, together with the original, at the CMBS in Winnipeg, Manitoba. Several of the location names are not correct. Some can not be positively identified and the cells are highlighted in yellow. These are noted in the comments column. Some surnames have been converted to more standard forms to make it easier to identify the individuals. Note that there is significant overlap between this list and that of Peter Peters. Missing information is indicated by blank grey cells.
