The original file contains documents in German and Russian. The genealogically useful information from both is incorporated into one spreadsheet since the Russian and German documents do not contain the same information. The German table was constructed in 1849 while the Russian census extracts come from the 9th national census of 1850. The ages given in the document are from the 1850 census extracts. A few things changed between the 1849 list and the 1850 census. Events such as marriages and births which occurred between the construction of the two lists are indicated in square brackets in the second last column. The last column includes the numbers for the household heads as found in the GRandMA database (note that the information from these lists has been added to the GRandMA database). It is unknown why the dates of settling in Russia are before the dates of the exit passes issued by the Prussian government.

The German document is found under the gargantuan single-sentence title: “*Verzeichniss des Molotschner Mennoniten Gebiets Amtes ueber die bis herige Auslaender Preussische Unterthanen Mennonitischen Glaubensbekenntnisses welche wuenchen auf immer in Russland zu verbleiben und in die Klasse der heisigen Ansiedler aufgenommen zu werden, denen auf die Dorfgemeinden der Molotschner Mennoniten Kolonien gegen Hierbringung ihrer Auswanderungs Consense in ihre Gemeinschaft aufzunehmen, durch Gemeindesprueche, ihre Zustimmung geben haben.*” Translating these kinds of sentences can be very challenging. One can’t help but admire the archives volunteers who are willing to tackle translations where entire pages are filled with such sentences.
